

How to Elect a Residency Preference

Step 1: Go to careers.dc.gov.

Step 2: Create an account.

Step 3: Locate the position for which you wish to apply.

Step 4: Follow steps one through four on the online job application.

Step 5: On the 5th step on the job application:

- Select “Yes” on Question 1 when asked if you are a resident of the District of Columbia;
- Select “Yes” on Question 2 when asked if you would like to claim a residency preference.
