



# What to do if you test positive for COVID-19

## Employee Steps



### 1. NOTIFY

If you test positive for COVID-19, immediately notify your supervisor or agency HR representative. Your supervisor or agency HR rep will let you know your available leave options or if you are eligible for situational telework.



### 2. STAY HOME

Care for yourself! Separate yourself from others and only leave the house to get medical care. Review DC health guidelines at a [coronavirus.dc.gov](https://www.coronavirus.dc.gov).



### 3. RETURN TO WORK

You may return to work after **all** of these conditions are met, and you only need to meet these conditions for ending home isolation to return to work. You must continue home isolation until:

- At least **10 days\*** have passed since your symptoms first started; **AND**
- At least 24 hours after your fever resolves without medication; **AND**
- Your other symptoms have improved.

\*If you tested positive, but never displayed any symptoms, you may only return after completing 10 days of self-isolation after the date of your positive test.
